9. General Background of Project or Assignment, Operational Context:

As per 2024 midyear statistics the Republic of Azerbaijan hosts some 1,551 refugees and 233 asylum seekers from Afghanistan, Russian Federation, Iran, Ukraine and other countries. Asylum seekers have access to national asylum procedures; however very few have been able to obtain formal recognition. In both cases, UNHCR provides them with the Protection Refugee Card recognized by the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the State Migration Service, and generally respects the non-refoulement principle.

The majority of refugees and asylum seekers currently reside in the urban areas of Baku and its surroundings. Since the progress achieved in the area of granting legal access to the labour market, which will have a long-run impact on the improvement of the socio-economic situation of persons of concern, has been very recent, in 2025 UNHCR will continue filling the gap in facilitating refugees' access to integration, including self-reliance opportunities, provision of basic and domestic items through allocation of multi-purpose grants.

Refugees and asylum-seekers still experience difficulties to a certain extent in accessing basic social services provided by the Government to local citizens. UNHCR has been providing assistance to refugees, asylum seekers and other persons of concern in Azerbaijan in terms of access to secondary health care services, education services, legal aid and other types of assistance.

Duties and responsibilities

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- In coordination with UNHCR, designs community-based protection activities, in particular with regard to two-way communication, community engagement and mobilization.
- Works with active refugee community volunteers to build sustainable refugee community networks.
- Organizes various events, meetings, awareness-raising and other activities for community members; maintains the schedule on a monthly basis;
- Shares relevant information with community members, connects them to local networks.
- Support UNHCR to mainstream the refugees and asylum seekers willing to be formally employed
 into the existing national mechanisms, primarily through the Employment centers and DOST
 centers under the MLSPP, through sister UN agencies and interested private sector partners;
- Support UNHCR in mainstreaming the refugees and asylum seekers to private companies for internships and employment, including subsidized employment;
- · Record all related information in UNHCR database
- Assessments / spot checks of the socio-economic situation of refugees and asylum seekers through home visits when referred by the UNHCR MFT.
- · Manage distribution of financial and in-kind assistance on ad-hoc basis
- If required, support conducting surveys, semi-structured interviews and focus group discussions among refugees and asylum-seekers
- Acts as interpreter/translator, if needed.
- Perform other related duties as required by supervisor
